



Automobiles, Boats, and Motorcycle Shipping

Before you decide to ship your private vehicle, boat, or motorcycle to another country, confirm any fees and import regulations applicable at destination.

Certain makes and types can be prohibited or may require entry permits and/or modifications to meet local emissions or safety standards. If you decide to take your car, check the availability of parts, unleaded or premium gasoline, and right- versus left-hand steering.

When shipping vehicles, nothing can be left in the interior or in the trunk, except normal accessories – such as a jack and spare tire. Some countries permit transporting the vehicle's hubcaps, extra air filters and/or engine parts in the trunk.
